(James 4:1-10)

- 1. Investigate the symptom.
 - Christians d<u>on't</u> h<u>ave</u> because they d<u>on't</u> a<u>sk</u>.
 - Excuses often take precedent over exercising faith.
- 2. I<u>dentify</u> the problem.
 - We love t<u>hings</u> and want to u<u>se</u> God.
 - We should love God and use things.
 - Christians fear God, but often follow other gods (2 Kings 17:33).
 - James calls this "spiritual a<u>dultery</u>".
- 3. Implement the solution from the word.
 - R<u>esist</u> the devil.
 - R<u>emain</u> near God.
 - Rebuke sin.
 - R<u>eturn</u> to joy.
 - Receive from God when you ask.
