Prayers from behind enemy lines.

1. Praying for boldness when opposition increases. Peter in Acts
 - “Lord, we ask that the Holy Spirit empower us to be an ever-faithful witness to the world around us. In the face of increasing pressure, may we have a boldness that only You can give, and may we never stop moving forward with the mission that You have entrusted to us.” **Acts 4:29-31** **Acts 5:40-42**
2. Praying that we will not be caught up in cultural defilement. Daniel in Babylon
 - “Lord, we purpose in our hearts not to become defiled by the culture around us. We understand that blending in may seem easier, but our intention is to please You above everyone else.” **Daniel 1:8**
3. Praying that we remain faithful when we feel abandoned. 3 Hebrews in Babylon
 - “Lord, may we remain faithful when we feel isolated in the battle. In the face of uncertain outcomes, help us to always stand for You, even when there seems to be no one else standing.” **Daniel 3:8-18**
4. Praying that we do what is necessary. Jesus
 - “Lord, we understand that the enemy would distract us and offer us shortcuts to accomplishing Your mission. Help us not be deceived and give us strength to do the difficult things ahead of us.”
